Bienalu na pot Our Biennale

1. septembra 1981 je prvič zazvonil šolski zvonec v novi stavbi na Nusdorferjevi. Štepanjsko naselje v Ljubljani je s tem pridobilo drugo šolsko stavbo, ki jo je takrat obiskovalo 580 učencev.

Pouk je takrat potekal v treh stavbah, in sicer v stavbi na Vlahovičevi (zgrajena 1976), na podružnični šoli v Hrušici, ki je bila postavljena že daljnega 1883 leta, ter na Nusdorferjevi. Vse tri stavbe so nosile ime partizanskega pesnika Karla Destovnika Kajuha.

V šolskem letu 1990/91 se je rodila odločitev, da se Osnovna šola Karla Destovnika Kajuha razdeli v dve samostojni ustanovi. Nova šola je dobila poimenovanje po znanem slikarju in grafiku Božidarju Jakcu. Formalen naziv OŠ Božidarja Jakca je nastopilo 1. avgusta 1992. V slovenskem prostoru se lahko s tem imenom ponašamo edini.

September 1st 1981 was the date and the day when a school bell rang for the first time in the new building on Nusdorferjeva Street. This is how Štepanjsko naselje in Ljubljana got a second school building with enrolled number of 850 pupils.

At that time classes were held on three different locations: on Vlahovičeva Street (built in 1976), in subsidiary school Hrušica which was built back in 1883 and on Nusdorferjeva Street. All three school buildings were named after a partisan poet Karel Destovnik Kajuh. In the school year 1990/91 a decision was made to divide Primary School Karel Destovnik Kajuh into two independent units. A new school was named after a well known painter and graphic designer Božidar Jakac. The official name was given to the school on August 1st 1992. Today we are very proud to be the only school in Slovenia with this name.



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Tako kot je dozorelo ime, je dozorevala pot našega bienala, začenši z vsem, kar je utiralo pot kulturno-umetniškemu področju; okrasitev šolskih hodnikov z risbami, oblikovanje šolskega logotipa, šolske zastave, ki jo krasí enostavna paleta na rumeni podlagi, do razstav različnih malih in velikih umetnikov, ki so krasile našo stavbo.
Verjetno se je tukaj nekje med idejami lepega začela tudi pot bienala – Otroškega likovnega bienala OŠ Božidarja Jakca z likovno nalogo RISBA. Prvi del je bil zaključen z izborom najboljših risb po mnenju strokovne komisije. Sklepno dejanje je pričajoči katalog, ki daje celotni ideji še dodatno težo.
Zahvala vsem, ki ste idejo začrtali in jo pripeljali do konca prvega dela začetniške poti. Bienalu smo namreč obljudili, da bo postal tradicionalen.

Posamezna šola je lahko v vsaki kategoriji sodelovala z enim izdelkom. Prvo selekcijo so naredili likovni pedagogi že na svoji šoli, nato pa so tri izbrana likovna dela (iz vsake triade enega) poslali na našo šolo. Tema in tehnika nista bili določeni. Velikost likovnega dela je bila velikost risalnega lista (format A3), dopustni pa so bili tudi manjši formati.


Pri ocenjevanju je upoštevana otroška kreativnost, inovativnost in vse vrednote otrokove risbe. Najboljši trije izdelki vsake kategorije so prejeli nagrado, v 1. in 3. triadi pa sta bili podeljeni po dve priznanji.

Every school was allowed to send three preselected drawings (one drawing in each category). A theme and a technique were not predetermined, while the size of a drawing was intended as A3 format even though pupils could participate with drawings of a smaller size.

All drawings were carefully examined by a three member board of experts:

Beatriz Tomšič Čerkez, PhD.
Črtomir Frelih, Master of Arts.
Jože Centa, BFA in painting.

In terms of assessment, the main criteria were considered to be child's creativity, originality and all the values of a child's drawing. The best three drawings received an award, while the pupils from 1st to 3rd grade received a recognition award.

This art contest is intended as a linking project between pupils, Slovenian primary school art teachers and the Department of Fine Arts of Faculty of Education in Ljubljana.

The art biennale of Primary school Božidar Jakac made a successful introduction by organizing an art contest. Our wish is to become a traditional biennale widely known outside Slovenia as an international children's biennale.







Na osnovni šoli, ki nosi ime po odličnem umetniku in ustanovitelju slovenske likovne akademije Božidarju Jakcu, so se odločili, da njegov spomin počastijo z organiziranjem likovnega natečaja risbe. Prizadetni in uspešni likovni pedagog ter slikar Skender Bajrović je pripravil natečaj, na katerega so posamezne šole lahko poslale po eno risbo iz vsakega trileta osnovne šole. Tako je strokovna komisija predse dobila že na posameznih šolah izbrana dela, kar je omogočalo poseben vpogled v to, kaj pedagogi razumejo kot dobro risbo. Odločitev prav za risbo je iz več razlogov zelo koristna. Prva korist je v tem, da risba tudi danes velja kot temeljno likovno izrazilo.

Primary School Božidar Jakac named after a great artist and founder of Slovenian Art Academy Božidar Jakac has decided to honour his name and memory by organizing an art drawing contest under the mentorship of a very successful art teacher and painter Skender Bajrović. On this occasion individual schools were invited to send their drawings. As a result, the board of experts had a chance to examine what defines a good drawing. There are many reasons why a drawing was chosen as a main theme for this contest. Firstly, because nowadays a drawing as itself is still considered to be a fundamental way of expressing fine art. It unveils many different emotional, sensual and rational states of individual mind and movement.

Razkriva bogato paleto čustvenih, čutnih, racionalnih in emocionalnih stanj in vzugibov pri posamezniku, nastopa kot ekonomično izrazilo, saj od vsega opazovanega duhovno ekstrahirale le najpomembnejše oblike. Je odkrita in odkrivajoča, saj svojih odkritij, prvih zabeležk ne oblači in lepša s tonalitetami in barvitostjo. Največ raziskav otrokovega likovnega razvoja je potekalo prav na osnovi preučevanja otroških risb, zato je risba še danes referenčna točka za likovne pedagoge in likovno pedagogiko nasploh, kadar se hoče prebiti do globljih spoznanj o stanju likovne vzgoje v določenem kulturnem prostoru.

Tokratni prerez zaradi relativno majhnega vzorca morda ni najbolj reprezentativen, kaže pa nekaj znakov, ob katerih se velja zamisliti.

Secondly, the absence of colours and tonality in a drawing gives a drawing a special meaning and value in the world of art. Therefore, a drawing itself becomes uncovered and revealing at the same time. The majority of research which have been studying how children progress and develop their skills in the field of art have used a drawing as a referential point in order to comprehend the role of an art class in a particular cultural millet.

It has to be mentioned that because of a relatively small pattern of drawings in this contest we can talk only about certain common signs or points (as opposed to conclusions on a global level) which shouldn't be ignored nor disregarded.

Najprej nekaj besed o učencih. Vsekakor današnje generacije živijo v bistveno drugačnem okolju, kot je vladalo v času postavitev glavnih likovno-pedagoških načel, razvojni psihologi celo opozarjajo, da imamo opraviti s tako drugačnimi subjekti, da bi veljalo stare teorije premisliti na novo. Za likovno področje je pomembno dejstvo, da danes otroci največ informacij dobijo posredno, prek vmesnikov, kar pomeni, da so današnji otroci bistveno bolje informirani, a imajo precej manj neposrednih izkušenj, posledično imajo tudi čustveno manj angažiran odnos do okolja. Ta izkušenjski in emocionalni deficit se na risbah kaže kot posplošene formulacije brez občutka osebne vpletosti.

Firstly, some words about the pupils-they live in a completely different environment from the times when main art pedagogical principles were established. Psychologists are saying that we are dealing with entirely different subjects which require new theories. In the field of art it is important to bear in mind the following ambiguity: On one hand, children nowadays receive much more information than ever before, but on the other hand they are less experienced and are, therefore, less emotionally related to their environment as their peers in the past. This form of emotional and experiential deficit can be seen in drawings as generalized formulations without any personal involvement.





Izkušeni pedagogi sicer najdejo načine motiviranja in večjega osebnega angažmaja učencev, a celota daje vtis tiste distance, ki jo v sodobnosti vmesniki zarinejo v razpolo med subjektom in neposredno, avtentično izkušnjo. Imamo opravka z neopazno, a pomembno spremembo zamenjav med likovnim in vizualnim, ko enačimo med »domaćim jezikom vizualnega in tujim jezikom likovnega«. (J. Muhovič)

Pri učiteljih gre za dva izobrazbeni profila; razredni učitelji v prvi in drugi triadi pokrivajo otrokove najbolj občutljive razvojne faze in kot nespecialisti vedno ravnačajo v dobravi, a včasih manj ustrezno. Predmetni učitelji nadaljujejo delo s populacijo, ki je že profilirana in morajo iz nje potegniti še zadnje ostanke odprtosti za likovno gledanje,

Even though there are still teachers who are able to motivate sufficiently their pupils to get more involved in the process of learning, there is a general impression of certain distance which in modern times is seen as a gap between the subject and an indirect, authentic experience. We are dealing with unnoticeable, but important change between fine art and visual, when we are equating between "the domestic language of the visual and the foreign language of fine art".

Regarding primary school teachers we have to differentiate between the teachers who teach pupils from 1st to 6th grade and the teachers of 7th to 9th graders. The first ones are dealing with children in their utmost sensitive development stages and as are always doing their best.



V res skopo odmerjenem času, ki ne omogoča elegantnejših, zanimivejših didaktičnih pristopov, ampak je prisiljena v vsakovrstno ekonomicnost in združevanje likovnih nalog, likovna vzgoja težko dosega zastavljene cilje. Da ne bi ostal le pri ugotavljanju stanja, predlagam nekatere spremembe v odnosu do likovne vzgoje in predvsem učencev v njej:

Likovni vzgoji je treba povrniti potreben čas, da cilje dosega na način, ki je likovnemu jeziku in oblikovalnim procesom lasten in po poteh, ki so za učence zanimive in osrečujuče.

Since they are non-experts in the field of fine art their methods sometimes prove not to be as the most effective way of teaching art. Teachers of twelve to fourteen year olds are very well aware of the fact that they are dealing with already profiled population with their own way of thinking and understanding the surroundings. Subsequently, these teachers can merely try to present the art language as an effective tool for expressing your feelings and emotions through fine art expression. Considering the time limit and the absence of new didactic techniques and approaches, it is absolutely clear that the art class inside the school curriculum cannot fulfil its goals. In order to change the attitude towards art class, I recommend the following changes:

Treba je povrniti kurikularno ravnovesje, saj dominacija leve možanske hemisfere nad celotnim procesom učenja opazno krni učenčeve celovitost.

Pouk likovne vzgoje v prvih dveh triadah naj prevzamejo likovni pedagogi, saj če razumemo likovni jezik kot tuji jezik, obstaja zadost argumentov in zgledov v primeru ostalih tujih jezikov. Če pa predmet razumemo kot estetsko ali kulturno vzgojo, ročne spretnosti ali vzgojo dobrega okusa, potem predmet z majhno doizobrazbo lahko uči skoraj kdorkoli. Te čudaške možnosti ne bi omenjal, če ne bi bili s podobnimi predlogi tudi v resnici že sooočeni ...

The art class needs to get back the time so that the goals will be achieved in a way close to the art language and use different approaches which will be interesting for the pupils.

A curriculum balance needs to be restored, because the dominance of the left brain hemisphere influences negatively on pupils' integrity.

The art class from the 1st to 6th grade should be taught by the art teachers similar to teaching foreign languages. There have been many arguments for supporting this point of view. On the other hand, if we understand art class merely as a cultural education or craft education, almost everybody with basic qualifications can teach art class. I wouldn't even mention this absurd standpoint, if similar ideas didn't come to my knowledge.


Učiteljem je treba tudi v nadaljevanju omogočiti doizobraževanje in strokovno izpopolnjevanje, ob strokovni pomoči pa bi bilo smiselno uvesti še kakšno obliko kontrole, saj je razvidno, da imamo opravka tako z nadpovprečno angažiranimi učitelji, kot tudi s takimi, ki do rezultatov prihajajo po strokovno problematičnih poteh.

Risbe, predstavljene na današnji razstavi, so izbrane, uspešno so prestale dvojno selekcijo in zato jih moje kritične pripombe ne zadevajo.

We need to identify the errors which occur in the process from concept to realisation, from faculty to class and then find a way to trespass these errors.

Teachers should be given additional opportunities for supplementary training in the field of fine art. Furthermore, a certain control mechanism should be established for supervising teachers' work because it is evident that we are not dealing only with highly motivated teachers but also with the ones who reach educational goals in a less professional manner.

Drawings presented at today's exhibition have successfully passed a double selection and can, therefore, in no case been considered as a subject of my criticism.





Dokazujejo namreč, da je risba lahko celovito, zaključeno likovno delo in predvsem podčrtajo njen pomen danes, ko ni več edina osnova za prinašanje oblik v podobe. Prednost njene oblikotvorne moči pred vizualnim podobotvorjem presega okvire predmeta likovna vzgoja in prav bi bilo, da bi se ta vednost razširila na vse, ki skrbijo za kvalitetno javno šolo.


